What is my Library Link number?

- 990000 (four zeroes) followed by your 7-digit Student ID Number to create a 13-digit number.

Example: If your Student ID Number is 1234567, your Library Link number is 9900001234567.

- Your Student ID Number can be found at the top of any report card or on [The Source](#).
- Your PIN is the MMDD of your birthday, 2 digits for the month and 2 digits for the day.

Example: If you were born on November 7th, your PIN is 1107.

- Your PIN is based on the birthday that Seattle Public Schools has on record.

All Seattle Public Schools students, teachers and staff automatically have a Library Link (www.spl.org/LibraryLink).
